Mills called the CCPD to report that Kesting had visited her in South Carolina and wanted her to cause the death of a man named "Woody Thompson." Mills advised that she is a "High Priestess of Voodoo" and Kesting came to her in late August at her business. Kesting allegedly had seen Mills' ad in a paper and came by. Kesting had asked for prayer for her personal finances and protection for her family. Kesting then informed Mills that she had recently lost a political election in Cobb County. She advised that during the election her opponent had cheated and smeared her name.

Kesting gave Mills a photo of an older man with glasses. She stated Kesting told her it was "Woody Thompson" the political rival. Kesting then requested that Mills perform a "death ritual" to cause the death of Thompson. Mills stated that Kesting wanted Thompson to "catch cancer" or "have a car accident." Mills advised that Kesting gave her a check for \$2,000 for the ritual on 08/27/08. She stated that another check for \$1,000 was post dated 09/11/08, also for the same ritual. Mills advised she went to cash the checks but there were insufficient funds.

I inquired if Mills had, in fact, conducted any type of "death ritual." She stated that a true priest or priestess of Voodoo would not intentionally cause the death of another. She advised that a "root worker" would be someone in the Voodoo religion that would conduct those types of rituals. According to Mills, the ritual would be called a "bloodbath" where a chicken would be killed. For example, if a car accident was intended, the blood from the chicken would be smeared on the tires of the intended victims' vehicle. The spell would then cause the accident.

Mills advised that she last spoke with Kesting earlier today. She demanded that Kesting pay her money. According to Mills, Kesting told her she was going to report her to the police for harassment. Mills stated that was when she decided to contact local authorities and advise them of the checks and the death rituals.

Mills stated that Kesting had paid the \$2,000 money from the first check. However, from the conversation today she was told

to wait a few days and then try to the second check again. I informed Mills that if the check still had insufficient funds, and she wished to open an investigation, she would need to contact her local sheriffs office, the Ridgeland County Sheriffs Office. Mills stated that she was concerned for the safety of "Woody Thompson" and wanted to notify authorities of Kesting's wishes. She also stated that she still had the checks and the photo of Thompson that Kesting provided her.

In regards to the "death rituals" there does not appear to be any crime that has been committed. Therefore, the investigation into the death rituals will be EXCEPTIONALLY CLEARED.
