Capital Murder

In the Name and by Authority of the State of Texas:

Before me, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared **Detective Ryan Ball** who after being, by me, duly sworn on oath deposes and says that he has good reason to believe and does believe based on the following information to wit:

On 6/27/09 at 0146hours, NPD received a call of a gunshot victim at 603 Old Tyler Road (in the City and County of Nacogdoches). NPD Dispatch learned that the suspect vehicle was possibly a blue Dodge Durango that had fled the scene northbound on Old Tyler Road. Ofc. Davidson began searching for the vehicle and observed a blue Dodge Durango northbound on Old Tyler Road. Ofc. Davidson attempted to perform a traffic stop on the vehicle and a said vehicle did not immediately stop. Near the intersection of Old Tyler Road and CR 804, a black male exited the vehicle holding an object in his hand. The remaining four occupants of the vehicle were detained. Ofc. Mobley, who was at the crime scene, learned that the victim was Michael Mott.

Subsequent interviews of the four occupants of the blue Dodge Durango revealed that the person that fled from the vehicle was Nickevette Ronshondo Carey, and that they had all been together at the business located at 603 Old Tyler Road. The occupants of the vehicle that were being detained advised that they, including Carey, had observed Mott to be in possession of a large sum of money inside the business. The occupants further stated that Carey made reference to robbing Michael Mott prior to the shooting. Carey exited the business prior to the occupants, who walked out shortly afterwards. As the occupants were standing outside, they heard several gunshots. The above-mentioned occupants then fled the scene, but were shortly contacted via cellular phone by Carey who requested they pick him up at the intersection of Powers and Old Tyler Streets. When they arrived at said intersection, Nickevette Carey entered the blue Dodge Durango with a handgun in one hand and a sum of money in the other and made a statement that indicated he shot and robbed Michael Mott.

Michael Mott later died as a result of gunshot wounds sustained in this incident.


Affiant is a Criminal Investigator with the Nacogdoches Police Department and as such is a certified peace officer with the State of Texas and that he charges that heretofore, and before the making and filing of this complaint on or about the 26th day of June, A.D. 2009, in the County of Nacogdoches and the State of Texas, Nickevette Ronshondo Carey, did then and there intentionally cause the death of an individual, namely, Michael Mott, by shooting him, and the defendant was then and there in the course of committing or attempting to commit the offense of Aggravated Robbery of Michael Mott.
