

FELONY COMPLAINT/AFFIDAVIT

In the Name and by the Authority of the State of Texas

I, J. Watson, have good reason to believe and do believe that, Baldemar Vela, who is hereafter called "Defendant," on or about the 22nd day of October, 2007, and before the making and filing of this complaint, in the City of Round Rock, County of Williamson and State of Texas, did then and there unlawfully, with the intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of the defendant, photograph another, namely Mindy Lunley, without the consent of the said Mindy Lunley.

Affiant has learned the following facts:

I, Ofc. J. Watson #3038, the undersigned affiant, am a sworn Police Officer employed by the Round Rock Police Department.

On 10/22/07 I was dispatched to Wal Mart, 4700 E. Palm Valley Blvd, Round Rock, Williamson County, Texas, concerning an employee that had taken an unwanted photo of a customer. Upon arrival, I spoke with the victim Mindy Lunley. She stated that while shopping she heard a person walking behind her. She then heard the sound of a camera and turned around. When she did, she observed the Defendant move his hand quickly to his ear while holding his phone. She then became irate and concerned that he had taken a picture of her butt. She then quickly took his picture with her own camera phone and proceeded to the management to complain.

I then met with the Defendant. I read the Defendant his Miranda Warning. While being questioned, he admitted to following the victim because he liked the way her butt looked. When he was close enough, he used his camera phone to take a picture of her butt. He stated later that he found the pictures of womens butt's were gratifying to him and that he has masturbated on more than one occasion to such pictures.

Upon arrival to the Round Rock Police Department, the Defendant was further interview by Sgt. D. Bayles. During the interview, it was learned that the Defendant had taken as many as twenty pictures of women's butt's.
